Atrium Experiences: K-Grade 5

The atriums are stations or rooms set up for the various components of Worshipful Wednesdays.

Art & the Bible-A lectionary reading or applicable Scripture/theme will be explored through art. Many of the art works/pieces can be found on the Vanderbilt School of Theology website: *lectionary.library.vanderbilt.edu*.

Choir-Children learn how best to cultivate their musical and vocal gifts for ministry and service.

Choirchime- (Grades 3-5) An introduction to handbell ringing through the use of chimes. (*periodic*)

Hymns & Liturgy-Children are familiarized with the hymns/canticles and spoken/musical responses for the upcoming Sunday(s) services.

Junior Deacon-(Grade 5) Children learn to minister and serve in the model of a deacon. (*periodic*)

Music Discovery-(K, Grades 1, & 2) A “hands-on” creative, learning experience with plenty of manipulatives to teach the basics of music.

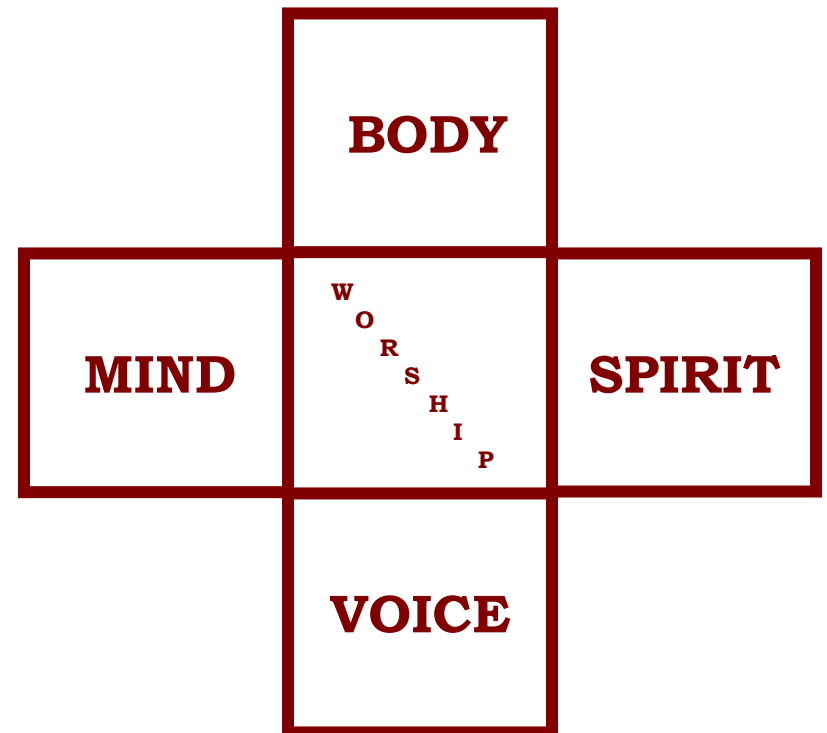
Recreation-An organized spontaneity of play using gross motor games and activities.

Voice for Life-(Grades 2, 3, 4, & 5) A curriculum of five components emphasizing voice building, musical understanding, repertoire (songs/anthems), responsibility, and community building. Ribbons and medals are awarded and worn with their choir vestment upon completion of a level.
